




## What's SAF?

As the SOS Amazonia Fund, we have successfully raised funds to initiate numerous projects. Notably, SAF became the inaugural beneficiary of a sequence of generous donations from *The Greta Thunberg Foundation* in 2020 (read more here). These funds were directed towards combating the COVID-19 pandemic in Manaus, the largest city in the Amazon Rainforest.

Through our engagement in five impactful projects spanning areas such as Food Sovereignty, Solar Energy, Health, Women Empowerment, and Climate Education, we have made a direct and meaningful impact on the lives of over 10,000 individuals in the Brazilian Amazonia, both through short-term interventions and long-term initiatives. ### Daniel Holanda


